



OPENING OF LOCAL ASSISTANCE CENTER FOR THE CORRALITOS RESIDENTS AFFECTED BY THE SUMMIT FIRE

In coordination with the Governor's Office of Emergency Services, the Santa Cruz County Operational Area will open a Local Assistance Center for those who experienced loss as a result of the May 22, 2008 "Summit Fire" in Santa Cruz County.

The Local Assistance Center will provide a single place for victims of the wildfire to get help in starting their recovery process. Selected state, county, local, and non profit, agencies will be providing information to assist those who have been displaced by the wildfire.

The center will be open Thursday, June 12, 2008, through Friday, June 13, 2008, from 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. to provide services.
